Databases

[Cataloging Legal Literature](#) | August 2016

- Print/online resource
- Describes current cataloging/classification procedures for legal materials
- Part 1 covers common publication questions
- Part 2 is an alphabetical listing of legal terms, genres, and more
- Updated to latest RDA standards
- Provides descriptive examples of cataloging recommendations
- Includes examples of genre/form terms
- Database version of 4th edition and all prior print editions included
- Updated quarterly

- Revised and historical statutes **only** provided for Manitoba, Newfoundland and Labrador, Prince Edward Island, Quebec, and Saskatchewan
- Available for **one-time** purchase or **free** for Canadian Core subscribers

[Brennan Center for Justice Publications at NYU School of Law](#) | October 2016

- Added **free of charge** to all U.S. Core subscriptions!
- The Brennan Center is a nonpartisan law and policy group seeking to improve the systems of democracy and justice in the United States
- More than 200 current and historical publications which are extensively peer-reviewed
- Many are full color PDFs

Databases

[*Multinational Sources Compared: A Subject and Jurisdiction Index*](#) | March 2017

- Print/online resource
- Impressive collection of detailed bibliographic records on more than 250 subjects
- Based on two prior titles: *Statutes Compared* and *Multinational Statutes Compared*
- Database enables users to browse content by title, publisher, subject, or jurisdiction
- Predecessor print editions available in PDF format

[*Reports of U.S. Presidential Commissions and Other Advisory Bodies*](#) | April 2017

- Print/online resource
- Contains the most current and extensive listing of publications created by presidential advisory bodies available
- Will be regularly updated
- Contains more than **6,000** database entries from the administrations of Andrew Jackson to Barack Obama
- More than **1,200** of these entries link to full-text documents
- Also includes hearings, scholarly articles and more!

Databases

[Hackney Publications](#) | April 2017

- Hackney Publications explore the legal side of sports in depth and delivers mission-critical information to professionals in the sports industry
- New packages in HeinOnline provide current content to key sports law titles: *Legal Issues in Collegiate Athletics*, *Journal of NCAA Compliance*, and *Professional Sports and the Law*
- Titles also added to Law Journal Library with an embargo at **no additional cost** to subscribers

- Print/online resource
- Includes Eugene G. Wanger's extensive bibliography which contains more than 7,000 entries of books, pamphlets, periodicals, posters, photos, and more
- Nearly 650 of these records link to full-text documents
- Related trials, congressional hearings, periodicals, scholarly articles, and more are also included

Sage Journal Packages | June 2017

- New partnership with SAGE Publishing brings 34 journals to the Law Journal Library with a three-year embargo **at no additional cost**
- Four new packages available for purchase through Hein which provide **access to current content** for the journals included in each package
- SAGE journal packages include Medical Legal, Legal Review, International Law, and Criminal Justice

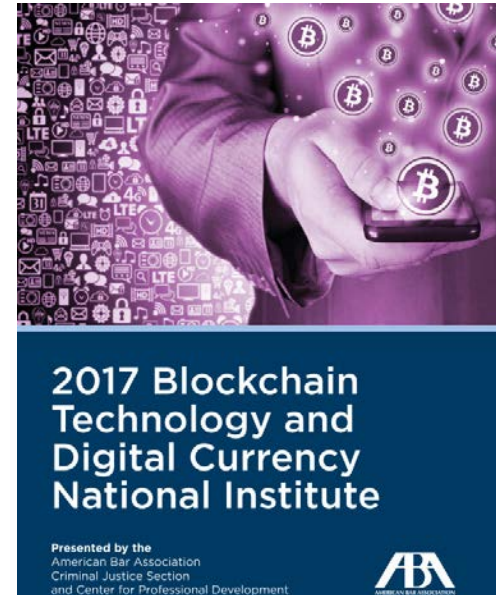
Key Content Updates

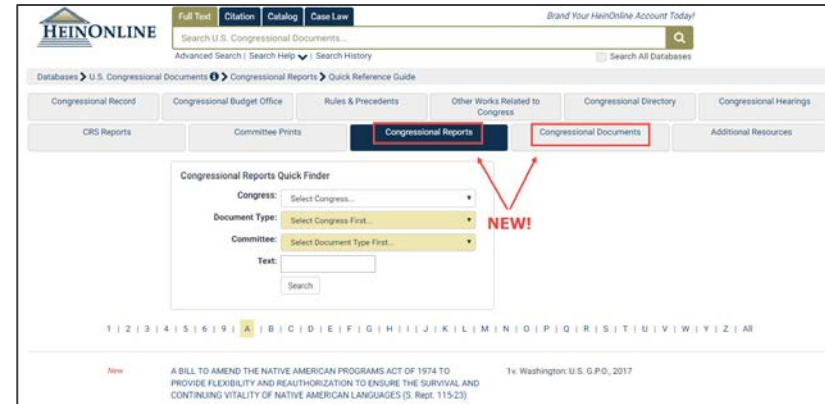

Infinite Scrolling

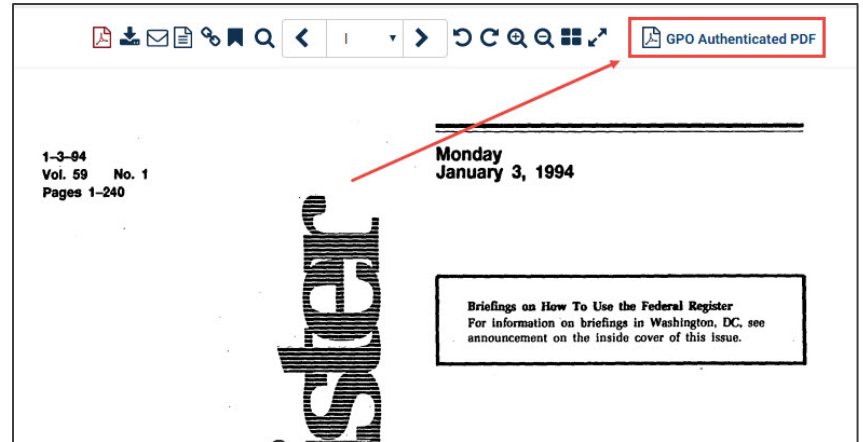
- Search results in HeinOnline have **always** been comprehensive, but users will no longer need to use page arrows to go beyond the first few results

Two [MyHein](#) Enhancements


- Implemented after receiving customer suggestions
